
# WEGNPSK (What Every Grade Nine Parent Should Know)

# Finding Your Way Around

- The school is a giant rectangle
- The boy's and girl's washrooms are on the same side of the school on each floor
- The first digit of the room numbers indicates the floor number
- Stairwell J is the easiest to use, it's to the left of the front doors
