Glebe SHSM Students Partner with Parkdale Food Centre

SHSM Non-Profit is up and running at Glebe!! Working with one other High School SHSM program, Brookfield, we have teamed up with the non-profit organization Parkdale Food Center (PFC).

The Parkdale Food Center is an organization which helps people that are in need of food. Upstairs is the food bank where people from the community all over would go once a month for a box of canned goods, dried foods, baby items, cooking essentials and pantry staples if needed. Downstairs of the PFC is a food service area that is open to the public for a community lunch. On Tuesdays and Thursdays the food service area is open from the time of 11am and closes at the time of 2pm. At the end of the month on a Wednesday the dining area will be open once a month from 9am to 11am for a community breakfast.

Parkdale Food Center is an astonishing friendly and an incredibly welcoming organization to the public. The Glebe and Brookfield students of the SHSM program are teaming up to serve the community; not only are we serving, we are also helping the chefs in the back prepare meals and cook with them. As we chop vegetables, slice fruits, prepare chicken and bake cookies, we are observing and learning the passions of our peers as we engage in conversations with the delightful chefs in the kitchen and the clients while eating together. This is a wonderful opportunity for the SHSM students to put themselves out there and show the community what pure kindness and joy means. We are a team and together we make the world go round!

SHSM - Non-Profit is for any grade 11 or 12 student interested in social justice, community and international development. Students participate in a co-op placement in the NGO world, they get extra certifications and training, opportunities for networking and exposure to post secondary opportunities and community events.
